The Fire of London

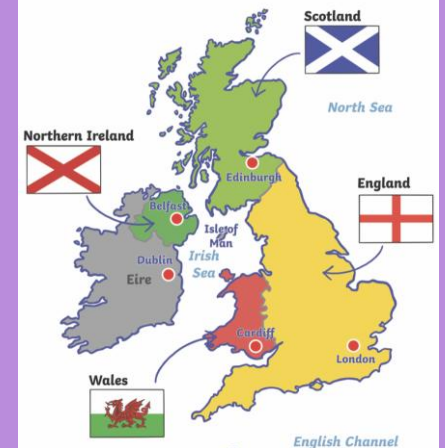
The fire started in Thomas Farriner's Bakery on Pudding Lane. It lasted 4 days, burned down 13,000 houses and 87 churches and 6 people died. The fire was so big because the houses were made from wood and straw and they were very close together, so it spread very quick. After the fire, the houses were rebuilt using bricks.

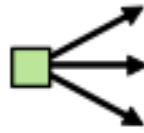

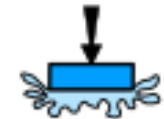

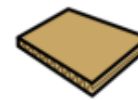
